## biography

Coming in hot after Chloe Ho, iiARA made her debut in 2024 with "Wake Up Slow", which she describes as "the initial feeling of transitioning from old friendships and relationships while struggling to find new places to call home".

Heavily influenced by Doechii, MacMiller and Little Simz, iiARA constantly embraces bold genres like Hip-Hop, trap, rap, and many more. She continuously experiments with her visual styles and performance practice to strengthen her narrative and express her rebellious nature.

Following this notion, iiARA released her following project in August 2025, "To the LOM" as a continuation to her debut, followed by a freestyle, "Cinema" in January 2025. Her impactful and unique lyricism captivates audiences, such as her recent appearance in Scape's Manifest! Music Day Out 2026.
